NOMINATION TO CLANS OF IRELAND ORDER OF MERIT

GUIDANCE NOTES

1 WHO MAY MAKE A NOMINATION

Any member(s) of an Irish Clan or Family registered with Clans of Ireland may make a nomination by completing a nomination form and obtaining the support of six others of the same clan.

2 COMPLETING THE NOMINATION FORM

Please complete the nomination form completely and accurately, following the instructions in each section closely. It is important that you provide as much information as possible about your nominee, and try to explain what their actual contribution in an area has been, as opposed to just listing jobs or posts held.

You may use additional sheets of paper, but please ensure that you state to which section the additional information you are providing relates. Please do not send in examples of the nominee's work (e.g. videos, photographs, books) as, we cannot take responsibility for their safekeeping.

3 NUMBER AND TYPE OF HONOURS

Clans of Ireland Order of Merit is given to Irish people and members of the Diaspora from all walks of life and all sections of society who have made a significant contribution to the promotion of Irish culture and heritage. Awards are made in a single class known as a *Companion of Clans of Ireland* or in Irish *Compánach Finte na hÉireann*. Recipients will receive the insignia of the Order and will be entitled to wear it at formal events and ceremonies.

The number of awards in the Order is strictly limited and therefore, however valuable their service, not everyone can receive recognition. It is important to realise that an honour will not automatically follow a submission.

4 WHO DECIDES?

The Council of Clans of Ireland Order of Merit is an independent body established by the board of Clans of Ireland to consider all nominations for appointment to the Order.

The Council considers whether a nominee to Clans of Ireland Order of Merit has:

- demonstrated achievement at a high level
- made a contribution over and above what might be reasonably expected through paid employment, or
- whose voluntary contribution to Irish heritage and culture stands out from others who have also made a valuable contribution.

5 TIMING OF NOMINATIONS AND AWARDS

The award of Companion in Clans of Ireland Order of Merit will be presented on 18 April 2020 at the Annual General Meeting in Ireland in the presence of representatives from registered Irish Clans. Consequently, completed nominations will need to be with Clans of Ireland postal address by 31 January, 2020.

Appointments in Clans of Ireland Order of Merit will be publicly announced on St. Patrick's Day, 17 March, 2018.

6 UNSUCCESSFUL NOMINATIONS AND RE-NOMINATIONS

If, your nominee has not been successful you may re-nominate at a later date.

The Council of Clans of Ireland Order of Merit will not provide feedback on individual nominations.

7 CONFIDENTIALITY

All nominations for Clans of Ireland Order of Merit are treated in the strictest confidence. It is desirable that the nominee should **not** be informed that they have been nominated, as it is not fair to raise expectations in case they are not met.

8 SUPPORT LETTERS

Letters of support should be from others who have first hand knowledge of and can endorse the nominee's contribution.

9 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND PROGRESS OF NOMINATIONS

Upon receipt of your nomination, we will send an acknowledgement. We regret that it is not possible to enter into correspondence on the merits of a particular nomination whilst it is under consideration.

10 CHANGES TO INFORMATION SUBMITTED

You may **not** send additional information to support the nomination after the deadline for submitting nominations has passed.

You must notify the Honours and Appointments Secretariat immediately if your nominee dies, as it is not possible for a posthumous award to be made.

11 NON - IRISH CITIZENS

People who are not Irish citizens are eligible to be considered for awards but they must be descended from an Irish family.
